

**Chestermere (Municipal) Crime Statistic Summary – January to May****2024/06/05***Chestermere (Municipal) – Highlights*

- **Break & Enters** are showing a 23.5% increase when compared to the same period in 2023 (January to May). There were 4 more actual occurrences (from 17 in 2023 to 21 in 2024).
- **Theft of Motor Vehicles** increased by 41.2% when compared to the same period in 2023 (January to May). There were 7 more actual occurrences (from 17 in 2023 to 24 in 2024).
- **Theft Under \$5,000** increased by 32.8% when compared to the same period in 2023 (January to May). There were 22 more actual occurrences (from 67 in 2023 to 89 in 2024).

Chestermere (Municipal) – Criminal Code Offences Summary

Crime Category	% Change 2023 – 2024 (January to May)
Total Persons Crime	12.9% Increase
Total Property Crime	49.3% Increase
Total Criminal Code	30.4% Increase

From January to May 2024, when compared to the same period in 2023, there have been:

- 15 more **Persons Crime** offences;
- 107 more **Property Crime** offences; and
- 116 more **Total Criminal Code** offences;

Chestermere (Municipal) – May, 2024

- There were 5 **Thefts of Motor Vehicles** in May: 0 cars, 3 trucks, 0 minivans, 2 SUVs, 0 motorcycles, 0 other types of vehicles, and 0 vehicles taken without consent.
- There were 3 **Break and Enters** in May: 0 businesses, 3 residences, 0 cottages/seasonal residences, 0 in some other type of location, and 0 unlawfully being in a dwelling house.
- There were a total of 5 **Provincial Roadside Suspensions** in May (4 alcohol related and 1 drug related). This brings the year-to-date total to 15 (13 alcohol related and 2 drug related).
- There were a total of 16 files with the **Spousal Abuse** survey code in May (May 2023: 16). This brings the year-to-date total to 78 (2023: 69).
- There were 373 files with **Victim Service Unit** referral scoring in Chestermere Municipal: 10 accepted, 43 declined, 4 proactive, 12 requested but not available, and 304 files with no victim.

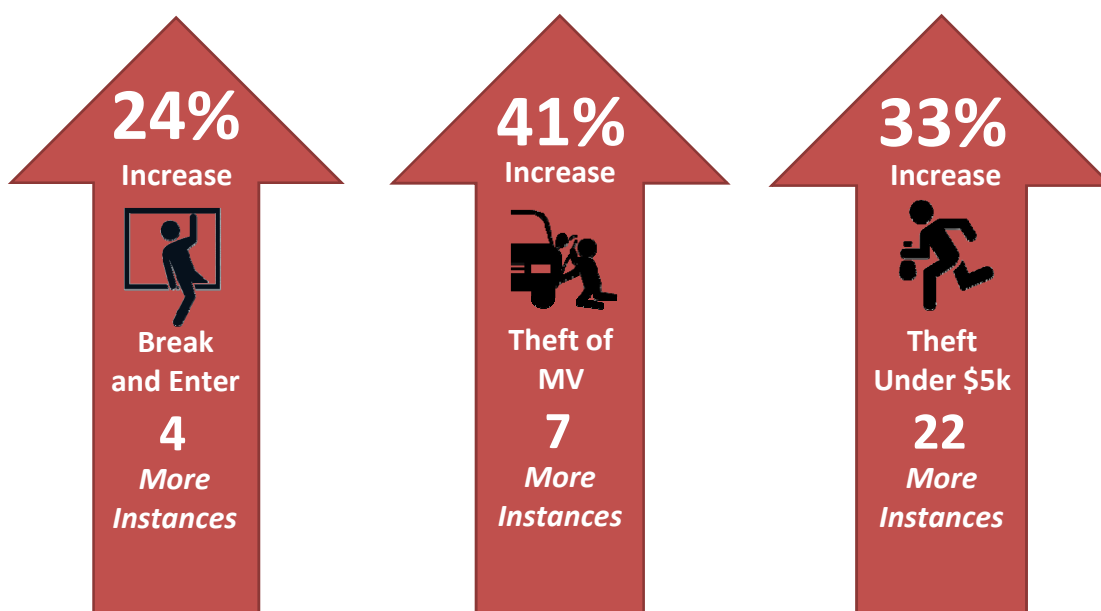
