_____ As per the Water Bylaw 025-13 and Wastewater Bylaw 027-13, the customer is responsible for all costs associated with relocating water and wastewater facilities. These costs include engineering drawings, approvals, construction, and an administration fee of 13%, to be paid by the responsible owner.

_____ The Connection Installer hereby certifies that this installation shall be completed in accordance with the National Plumbing Code (current edition) and shall commence within 90 days.

_____ The Landowner shall submit an Inspection Request Form to the City's file manager to schedule a Construction Completion Certificate (CCC) inspections during and after the completion of construction work for connecting to the City's existing Water & Sewer mainline within the City's right of way. The warranty for work within the City's right-of-way is for one year after CCC.

_____ The construction security will be reduced at 75% once the City deems the work acceptable and issues the Construction Completion Certificate (CCC) to the Landowner. The remaining security will be reduced following the completion of the one-year warranty period and a subsequent inspection.
