# A Message To The Community

## From The Community Services Department

It has been another remarkable year for the City of Chestermere and the Gifts of Kindness Fund.

With this time to prepare, we are able to strengthen the fund for the future, ensuring that resources are available when they are needed most.



# What Is Gifts Of Kindness?

**Gifts of Kindness is a municipally managed fund used for philanthropic support, and temporary emergency financial aid for local residents.**

The existence of Gifts of Kindness stems from the recognition that unexpected emergencies or unforeseen expenses can leave many individuals and families struggling to meet their basic needs.

During these times of heightened stress, Gifts of Kindness can alleviate financial burdens, allowing people to address the underlying causes of their situations, such as sudden unemployment, family breakdowns, medical issues, or other challenging circumstances. The Community Services team responsible for administering Gifts of Kindness funds also assists recipients by connecting them with additional resources to support their long-term goals.

Beyond addressing immediate needs, Gifts of Kindness raises awareness about the impact of poverty within the community. By sharing information about the support provided, it helps educate the community about the realities faced by many of our neighbours and friends. This, in turn, contributes to reducing the stigma associated with poverty, fostering a collective effort to support community members in need.

Upon referral, the City's Community Services team can meet with individuals or families experiencing financial hardship to discuss their current situation and offer strategies and resources that may provide financial relief.

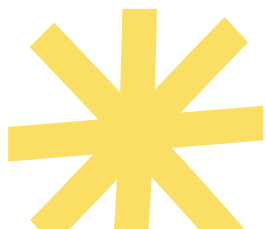


# What does **short term financial aid** include?

**Basic Needs Support:** We provide assistance for essential living expenses, including food, clothing, shelter, transportation, utilities, medication, phone bills, childcare fees, educational courses, home mobility renovations, and government application fees.

**Annual Programs:** Connect with a variety of programs offered throughout the year, such as the Community Access Program (CAP), transit subsidies, activities for children and youth, older adult programs, and more.

**Emergency Support:** In urgent situations, Gifts of Kindness can offer grocery and gas gift cards to help meet immediate needs.





## Challenges, Adjustments & Achievements:

Gifts of Kindness has done a commendable job so far by understanding and responding to the consistent needs of our community. Thanks to a strong partnership with the municipality, we have built a solid foundation. But to keep up with the steady demand, we are now focusing on bringing more outside donors on board to help keep the fund going strong for the long haul.

We truly believe this fund should be a community-driven effort—empowered by the people it serves. That is why we are actively exploring new partnerships and opportunities that can provide a steady stream of support. This forward-thinking approach will help us continue meeting the needs of our neighbours in meaningful ways.

## **What was the need?**

Despite prevailing national social trends, 2024 saw an unexpectedly low demand for resources—highlighting the strength of community support systems.

### **Major Needs Observed:**

1. Housing/Rent
2. Utilities
3. Health Support/Expenses

In total, Gifts of Kindness contributed **\$21,564.98** to support community members.



# Expense Breakdown

**\$21,564.98 Total funds spent to help 120 individuals**

(8 senior, 57 adult, 30 youth, 8 children) to maintain their housing, access medications and surgery, or to purchase groceries and other essential goods.

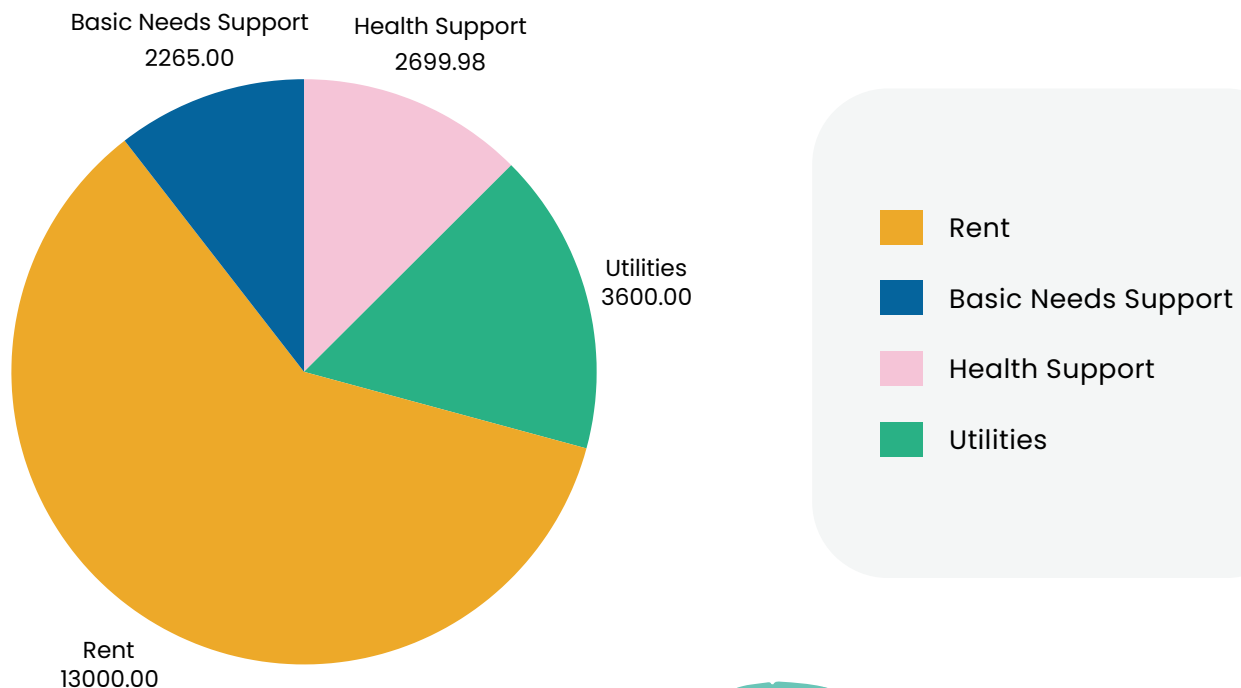
**57 Adults (18-64)**
