

TOWN OF CHESTERMERE

BYLAW 93-179/2

A BY-LAW FOR THE TOWN OF CHESTERMERE, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA TO PROVIDE FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A MUNICIPAL LIBRARY

WHEREAS the Council of the Town of Chestermere deems it expedient to propose the establishment of a municipal library.

NOW THEREFORE with the authority and under the provisions of Part II of "The Libraries Act" and Amendments thereto, being Chapter L-12.1 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1983, the council of the Town of Chestermere duly assembled enacts as follows:


1. There shall be established a municipal library for the Town of Chestermere.
2. The Municipal Library shall be managed, regulated and controlled by a Library Board.
3. The policies of the Municipal Library Board shall be governed by "The Libraries Act" and Amendments and Regulations pertaining thereto.
4. On being established, the municipal library board shall be known as the Town of Chestermere Library Board.
5. This ByLaw shall take effect on the date of the final passing thereof.

First reading passed in open council, assembled in the Town of Chestermere, in the Province of Alberta, this 15th day of November, 1993 on a motion by Councillor Emerson Shortt.
