

A By-law of the Summer Village of Chestermere Lake authorizing the Council to close the Road Allowance all that portion of Statutory Road Allowance adjoining the north boundary of the North East quarter of Section Ten (10), Township Twenty-four (24), Range twenty-eight (28), West of the Fourth (4) Meridian lying east of a line drawn from the North West corner of Lot 1, Block 1, Plan 3883JK to the South West corner of Lot 1, Block 4, Plan 3883JK and lying West of a line drawn from the North East corner of Lot 1, Block 1, Plan 3883JK to the South East corner of Lot 1, Block 4, Plan 3883JK, containing thirty-two hundredths (0.32) acres more or less.

All that portion of Statutory Road Allowance adjoining the north boundary of the North West quarter of Section Eleven (11), Township Twenty-Four (24), Range Twenty-Eight (28), West of the Fourth (4) Meridian lying east of a line drawn from the North West corner of Lot 1, Block 2, Plan 3883JK to the South West Corner of Lot 1, Block 3, Plan 3883JK and lying West of the production northerly across said Road Allowance of the East boundary of Lot 1, Block 2, Plan 3883JK containing Fifteen hundredths (0.15) acres more or less.

NOW/THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Council of the Summer Village of Chestermere Lake pursuant to the authority vested in it by Section 175 of the Municipal Government Act, Chapter 246, R.S.A. 1970 and amendments thereto, enacts as follows:

1. That a notice was published on November 25, 1977 and December 2, 1977 in the Calgary Herald, a newspaper serving the Summer Village, the last of said publications being at least two (2) weeks before the date fixed for the passing of this by-law.
2. That all persons having properties adjoining or adjacent to the areas proposed for closure, were notified by mail, and did not in the two (2) week period prescribed indicate that they would be prejudicially affected.
3. Whereas, Council was not petitioned for an opportunity to be heard by any person prejudicially affected by the by-law.
4. That the Council has ascertained that this road allowance is not required for public access purposes, and it is in the interest of the public that the said road allowance be closed.
5. That that portion of Statutory Road Allowance adjoining the north boundary of the North East quarter of Section Ten (10), Township Twenty-Four (24), Range Twenty-eight (28), West of the Fourth (4) Meridian lying east of a line drawn from the North West corner of Lot 1, Block 1, Plan 3883JK to the South West corner of Lot 1, Block 4, Plan 3883JK and lying West of a line drawn from the North East corner of Lot 1, Block 1, Plan 3883JK to the South East corner of Lot 1, Block 4, Plan 3883JK, containing thirty-two hundredths (0.32) acres more or less.

5. All that portion of Statutory Road Allowance adjoining the north boundary of the North West quarter of Section Eleven (11), Township Twenty-Four (24), Range Twenty-eight (28), West of the Fourth (4) Meridian lying east of a line drawn from the North West corner of Lot 1, Block 2, Plan 3883JK to the South West corner of Lot 1, Block 3, Plan 3883JK and lying West of the production northerly across said Road Allowance of the East boundary of Lot 1, Block 2, Plan 3883JK containing Fifteen hundredths (0.15) acres more or less.
6. That this By-Law shall be in full force and effect until it is repealed.
7. That this By-Law shall be subject to the approval of the Minister of Transportation.
8. That subject to the conditions contained in paragraph six (6) herein, this By-Law shall come into full force and effect upon third reading thereof.

First reading passed in open Council, assembled in the Village Office at Chestermere Lake in the Province of Alberta, this 27th day of March 1978, on a motion by Councillor Pallesen.
