**BYLAW # 006-24**

A Bylaw of the City of Chestermere, in the Province of Alberta, for the purpose of closing to public travel a portion of original government road allowance to create title in the name of the municipality for subsequent land transfer in accordance with Section 22 of the Municipal Government Act, Revised Statutes of Alberta 2000, Chapter M-26, as amended.

**WHEREAS** the lands hereafter described are no longer required for public travel;

**WHEREAS** City Administration has requested that Council approve having the original government road allowance closed;

**WHEREAS** the Council of the City of Chestermere deems it expedient to provide for a bylaw for the purpose of closing to public travel certain roads, or portions thereof, situated in the said municipality, and therefore disposing of the same;

**WHEREAS** notice of the intention of Council to pass a bylaw has been given in accordance with Section 606 of the Municipal Government Act;

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the Municipal Council of the City of Chestermere in the Province of Alberta does hereby close to public travel for the purpose of creating title to the municipality and subsequent land transfer for the following described road allowance, subject to rights of access granted by other legislation:

ALL THAT PORTION OF THE ORIGINAL GOVERNMENT ROAD ALLOWANCE ADJACENT TO THE WEST BOUNDARY OF THE **N.W. ¼ SEC.3, TWP.24, RGE.28, W.4<sup>TH</sup> M.** CONTAINING 0.33 HA (0.82 AC) MORE OR LESS AND AS SHOWN ON **SCHEDULE A** OF THIS BYLAW.

READ A SECOND TIME this 12 of march 2024.

READ A THIRD TIME this 12 of March 2024.
