BYLAW #007-23

A Bylaw of the City of Chestermere, in the Province of Alberta, to amend Bylaw 036-20 being the Traffic Control Bylaw.

WHEREAS pursuant to Section 7 of the Municipal Government Act, R.S.A. 2000, c. M-26, the council of a municipality may pass bylaws for municipal purposes respecting, among other things, (a) the safety, health, and welfare of people and the protection of people and property; (b) people, activities, and things in, on, or near a public place or place that is open to the public; (c) transport and transportation systems; and (d) the enforcement of such bylaws, including the creation of offences, the imposition of fines and imprisonment, the ability to conduct inspections and remedying contraventions of bylaws;

WHEREAS pursuant to Section 191 of the Municipal Government Act R.S.A.2000, Chapter M-26, a Council may, by Bylaw, amend Bylaws from time to time;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the City of Chestermere in the Province of Alberta deems it desirable to amend Bylaw 036-20 being the Traffic Control Bylaw;

NOW THEREFORE the Chestermere City Council duly assembled, enacts as follows:

1. Section 18 is amended to read:
"Permitted year-round. Seasonally, the City of Chestermere will operate three (3) public lake access points so that Off-Highway Vehicle operator may access the ice surface. The City will open these Lake Access points, once the Parks Department has determined that the ice surface is safe enough for public use of Off-Highway Vehicles. (See Schedule "C" FOR Lake Access points)"
2. Section 18.6(a) is amended to read:
"Permitted Off-Highway Vehicles shall not travel on a roadway where the speed limit exceeds 60 kilometers per hour."
3. Section 18.6(b) is amended to read:
The maximum speed limit of Permitted Off-Highway Vehicle may travel on a highway 60 kilometers per hour, or less if the posted speed limit is lower than 60 kilometers per hour.
4. Schedule A subsection 18(1)(b) is removed.
5. Schedule A subsection 18(1)(c) is removed.
6. Schedule A subsection 18(5)(e)(i) is amended to read:
"Operate OHV without a valid registration – Specified Penalty \$324.00 – Minimum Penalty \$200.00."

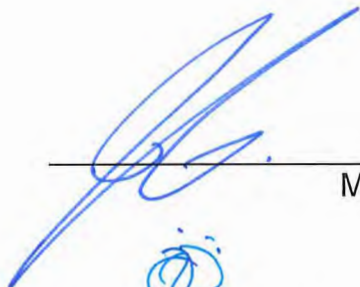
7. Schedule A subsection 18(5)(e)(ii) is amended to read:
"Operate OHV without insurance – Specified Penalty \$1000.00 – Minimum Penalty - \$1000.00."
8. Schedule A subsection 18(5)(e)(iii) is amended to read:
"Operate OHV without license plate visible – Specified Penalty \$324.00 – Minimum Penalty - \$200.00"
9. Schedule A subsection 18(6)(d) is amended to read:
"OHV fail to obey traffic control device – Specified Penalty \$243.00 – Minimum Penalty \$150.00"
