2025 Capital vs Operating Budget

What is a Capital & Operating Budget?

A capital budget is a plan for acquiring, maintaining, and replacing a municipality's physical assets. It's part of the annual budget and based on revenue projections.

An operating budget outlines spending on day-to-day operations, including employee salaries, utilities, and facility maintenance.

Each year, Chestermere prepares an annual capital budget and a 5-year plan. The capital budget is funded by grants, surplus accounts, levies, and utility rates. The operating budget is funded by property taxes, grants, investment revenue, and service charges.

Raised Crosswalks

Twinning of Chestermere Boulevard

Converting Chestermere Boulevard from two lanes to four lanes west of Rainbow Road will enhance connectivity between key areas in Chestermere, making travel more efficient for residents and commuters. Expanding the roadway will reduce traffic congestion and improve safety for all road users.

Additionally, better infrastructure can attract more businesses and investments, boosting the local economy. The project is also planned with a focus on sustainability, ensuring minimal disruptions during construction and maintaining high standards of quality. Overall, the twinning of Chestermere Boulevard is expected to bring long-term benefits to the community by improving transportation, safety, and economic opportunities.

Road Access to High School Site

The construction of an 800-meter road on West Merganser Drive marks an exciting milestone as it brings us closer to our new high school.

This road will be essential for accessing the high school site, promoting further development, and advancing the community towards this important initiative.





Rainbow Road North

The opening of Rainbow Road north of Windermere Drive will allow for all access turns, featuring streetlights and turn signals at the intersection, along with a westbound acceleration lane. Additionally, the road will be upgraded and paved.

This is pending approval from Alberta Transportation and aims to enhance traffic flow and safety for all road users.
