### PURPOSE AND INTENT

To provide strategies that allow for waterlines to be flushed in a safe and cost effective manner and to minimize the occurrence of activated alarms due to a high volume of flow from the Town's water reservoir.

### POLICY

1. Waterline flushing will only be permitted between the hours between 10:00 AM and 4:00 PM, Monday to Friday unless previously arranged and agreed to by the Town of Chestermere.
2. Whenever waterlines are flushed, either an employee of the Town of Chestermere Public Works staff or an employee of Epcor Water Services must be present at the job site.
3. Any overtime hours incurred by these employees for the above mentioned tasks, will be charged back to the contractor at their usual overtime rates of pay.
4. The Town's Fire Department is required to use specific fire hydrants in their practice sessions as indicated on maps provided by Epcor Water Services.
5. The Fire Department is to notify Epcor Water Services prior to using any fire hydrants during their practices.
