

**TOWN OF CHESTERMERE
PROVINCE OF ALBERTA
BY-LAW NO. 96-604/1**

WHEREAS Section 191.1 of the Municipal Government Act, Statutes of Alberta, 1994, Chapter M-26.1 provides that a Council of a Municipality may, by bylaw, repeal an Area Structure Plan which provides a framework for subsequent subdivision and development of an area of land within its Municipal boundaries; and

WHEREAS the Council of Town of Chestermere, in the Province of Alberta (hereinafter called the Council) did direct the preparation of an Area Structure Plan for those lands in the northeast quarter of Section 2, and the southeast and northwest half of Section 11, in Township 24, Range 28, West of the Fourth Meridian; and

WHEREAS the Area Structure Plan was adopted by Bylaw 83-061, cited as "The Southeast Chestermere Lake Area Structure Plan Bylaw"; and

WHEREAS the Council of the Town of Chestermere deems it desirable to Repeal the Area Structure Plan;


NOW THEREFORE the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Town of Chestermere, in the Province of Alberta, duly assembled, enacts as follows:

1. That ByLaw 83-061 and Bylaw 84-077 and all amendments thereto are hereby repealed.
2. This Bylaw comes into full force and effect upon third reading.
